On 20th & 21st September, Timperley Boneshakers will be undertaking our annual Charity Bike Ride. This year we are cycling 200 miles over the weekend. On Saturday we are cycling south through Cheshire and Shropshire to Shrewsbury, then heading northwards to Chirk in North Wales where we will stop overnight. On Sunday we will be cycling to Llangollen up to the summit of Horseshoe Pass, then returning to Timperley via Wrexham.

Our nominated charity is The Little Green Sock Project; this charity supports children living in poverty.

In Manchester 250,000 children are living in poverty with many lacking the basic essentials needed for a safe and happy childhood. From a stairgate to prevent home accidents, to a safe place for a baby to sleep, too often these items are seen as a luxury with many families going without. This charity's aim is to ease some of the stress and emotional weight for parents struggling to afford the essentials, while promoting sustainability and community kindness through reuse and thoughtful giving. Having visited the Charity recently, I was very impressed how gifted/donated clothing and second-hand equipment

was being repurposed for families and sent out for distribution on a referral basis.


